Short Synopsis: A man has everything taken from him, left questioning his faith and integrity, retaliation seems to be the only way to ease the Animus. Animus is a story about the power of hatred over the mind of a godly man, Rolando (Josue Aguirre) after being pushed too far by ruthless Cartel Lieutenant Fernando Fargas (Omar Saavedra).



About the Production:

'Animus' was conceived by Jake Armbruster while he was in college at Cal State University Northridge in late 2012. Jake's fascination with inherently 'good' characters, being driven to their breaking point was the main inspiration for the film. Animus' script was inspired by post classical 70's revenge films like 'The Outlaw Josey Wales,' 'Point Blank,' and more modern films like Park Chan-Wook's Revenge Trilogy. Jake decided early on that he wanted to make a film about an inherently 'good' man who is turns to murder. The script took on a life of it's own when he decided to explore taboo themes dealing with faith and religion. The final half of the film turns into a harrowing final sequence of murder and vengeance.

After finishing the script Jake approached his friend, actor Josue Aguirre to play the title role. Jake knew that with Josue's devout christian faith he would be able to relate to the characters struggle and would embody the character of 'Rolly.'.

During this time Jake had randomly met actor, Omar Saavedra at a bar. They both

made a quick connection with their love for films an found themselves having long conversations about characters and performances, Jake knew he found the man to play the evil cartel Lieutenant Fernando Fargas. With these two roles in place he moved forward with production and plans to raise funds to shoot the film. They created a Kickstarter campaign which raised a mere 3,000 dollars, but an amount that Jake thought he could work with. In order to make the

budget work, the production team took what locations they knew they could get for free or minimal pay and made changes to the script accordingly. Jake with his wife and Production Designer Rachael, used their own home and turned different rooms into sets for the film. This allowed them to condense days and not have to up-root the production to move to multiple locations, saving them thousands in the process.

Principle photography for 'Animus'


began in June of 2013. The 'budget' was expended in the first three days of shooting forcing Jake to take on a 'shoot when you can' approach. The film completed Production almost a year later in 2014. Having no budget for Post-Production, the film took another year to be completed finishing in the spring of 2015. As Jake put it in his twitter post, "Editing 'Animus' has been an enlightening experience.


Christina Mendoza Lopez




